## Chanticleer Swim Club Contract for Pool Rental

- 1. Pool must be rented by a member in good standing, only members over 21 years old can rent the pool for a private party. **The member renting the pool must be at the party from start to finish.**
- 2. Cost of the party: \$150 = 8pm to 11pm- -\$50 for each additional hour
  - A: Parties up to 50 guests: Price includes 2 lifeguards, manager or head lifeguard fees.
  - B: Parties of 51-75 guests: will need 1 additional guard @\$50.00 which will be added to the total Parties of 76-100 guests require 2 additional guards @\$100.00 which will be added to the total
  - C: Deposit of \$100.00 is required 2 weeks before the date of the party. The date is not reserved until the deposit is received. The balance is due 5 days prior to the date of the party.
  - D: A cleaning deposit is not required at the time you book the party. If your party area is not cleaned up properly then you will be billed a \$50 cleaning charge. If any damages occur, you are responsible for the cost to repair/replace.
- 3. Snack Shack and Manager's office are not part of the rental. You and your guests are not permitted to use the building or equipment inside the building.
- 4. Clean up must be completed by the end of the party.
  - A: Pool must be left in the same condition as before the party

Which includes the following:

- 1. Bathrooms
- 2. Pool Deck
- 3. Grass Area
- 4. Area under and near the snack shack roof
- 5. Volleyball Court area
- 6. Grills
- 7. Patio area
- 5. Property Damage: All property damage will be repaired or replaced at your cost. Any costs t will be charged to the member, who has 10 days to make payment.
- 6. Rules: A: All rules of the pool will be enforced.
  - B: Any excessive rule infractions will end the party with no refund.
  - C: All music will be turned off at midnight.
  - D: If alcoholic beverages are on the premises, member will take full and sole responsibility for policing those participants in attendance. If anyone under 21 years old is drinking, the member will lose their membership, the party ends and the police will be called. If a lifeguard or manager observes that one of your guests has exceeded their alcoholic limit, they have the right to stop that person from entering the pool.
- 7. Tipping lifeguards or manager is allowed.
