

Chanticleer swim Club Rules and Regulations

The following rules and regulations are for the protection, safety, and benefit of all individuals. These rules have been established to assure safe and sanitary operation of the pool facilities according to Health Department standards. Parents are requested to caution their children to observe all rules and to obey the instructions of the pool manager and other employees. Any failure to do so shall be considered sufficient cause for cancellation of membership. **Please be**

- * **advised that by order of the County of Allegheny Department of Health, there is no**
 - * **smoking permitted on the premises. No smoking, vaping, or electronic cigarettes on pool property.**
1. Pool Hours: Mon. -Thur 12:00 Noon to 8:00 pm / Fri. 12:00 Noon to 9:00 pm / Sat. 11:00 am to 9pm / Sun.-Holidays 11:00am to 8:00 pm
 - * **2. All activities in the pool and enforcement of rules are subject to conditions and are at the discretion of the lifeguards. If the guard feels that any activity is unsafe or a disturbance to others, they are permitted to disallow that activity.**
 - * 3. The pool manager is required to enforce these rules and regulations and is permitted to restrict any member or guest of the pool for any infraction of these rules.
 - * 4. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The club will not be responsible for any accidents or injury in connection with such use.
 5. Pool Admittance: Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted to enter the pool grounds without supervision. Supervision to mean any person who is 15 years of age or older.
 - * 6. Parents or guardians are ultimately responsible for the BEHAVIOR AND SUPERVISION OF THEIR CHILDREN REGARDLESS OF AGE. This is not the responsibility of the manager or the life guards.
 7. In order to preserve unobstructed access to all areas of the pool, chairs are not permitted along the pools edge or the first block of concrete surrounding the pool.
 - * 8. NO GLASS containers of any kind are allowed in the pool area or on the lawn. Food and drinks are not allowed in or over the pool.
 - * 9. No running, pushing, wrestling, ball playing, or causing undue disturbances will be permitted on or about the pool area (concrete).
 10. No pets are allowed within the pool grounds.
 11. Admission may be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, infections, or wearing bandages.
 12. The club will not be responsible for loss of or damage to personal property.
 13. The cost of any damages to pool property will be charged to the member responsible.
 - * **14. No abusive language will be tolerated.**
 15. Members and guests shall drive slowly and carefully in the driveway and parking areas. NO TIRE SPINNING OR EXCESSIVE HORN BLOWING.
 16. All children not completely toilet trained MUST wear a swim diaper while in either pool. This is for safety and sanitation. If an accident should occur, please notify the manager or a life guard immediately.
 17. The Kiddie pool is restricted to use by children five (5) years of age and younger. **All children using this pool must be accompanied by an adult who remains in the kiddie pool area at all times.**
 18. Climbing on the top of the kiddie pool whale and /or covering or redirecting the fountain's stream is prohibited.
 19. Children wearing floaties must be accompanied by an adult. No floaties permitted in deep end.
 20. **All children are required to pass a deep water test with a lifeguard before they are permitted to be in the deep end.**
 21. Floating equipment will not be permitted, except in the Kiddie pool or during holiday activities or special events.
 22. Infant floating equipment is permitted during adult swim.
 23. **No rafts or tubes, only noodles are permitted.**
 24. **No hitting others with noodles.**
 25. Kickboards for swim team and for use by adults during adult swim.
 - * 26. **No balls are permitted with the exception of soft water balls.**
 - * 27. ADULT SWIMS: Will be called at 45 minutes past each hour for swimmers 18 years of age and older, high school graduates, or pool employees.
 28. No children (or their feet) are to be in the pool during adult swim.
 29. **No splashing adults or shooting water guns during adult swim.**
 30. No diving from the sides or end wall of the shallow end, or from the deep end side walls. Diving is only permitted at the **deep end.**
 31. **Flipping is only permitted from the spring board, NOT from any side of the pool.**
 32. No running when jumping into the pool. One may only start the jump (run) from the first block of cement or the length of the diving board at the diving board end.
 33. **No holding another person underwater, grabbing or dunking anyone by their neck or head.**
 34. **No getting on the shoulders of another person or playing "chicken".**
 35. **No breath holding games or "bubbles" game.**
 36. **No holding onto any lane rope.**
 37. **No throwing children in the water when the pool is crowded.**
 38. **No spitting anywhere on pool grounds.**
 39. **No blowing of nose in water.**
 40. **No placing ANYTHING into the pool skimmers.**
 41. SPRING BOARD RULES:
 - a) FORWARD APPROACHES ONLY.
 - b) FEET FIRST ENTRY ONLY - NO DIVING -AND EXIT POOL AT ONE OF THE LADDERS.
 - c) Only one person will be permitted on the board.
 - d) **Jumpers must wait until the last person is at the wall before the next person gets on the board.**
 - e) Each person is responsible for the area under the board, and will not jump until he/she is sure that the area is clear.
 - f) Swimming directly under the board is prohibited when the diving board is in use.
 - g) ONLY ONE BOUNCE is permitted in using the spring board.
 - h) "Catching" children from the Spring Board is prohibited.
 - i) Swim away from the board to the shallow end, or the side of pool (ladders).
 42. GUESTS:
 - a) The gate attendant will take the member's name and those family members swimming each day on a daily sign in sheet.
 - b) Guests will be signed in by the member on the guest card with name, address, and classification. The gate attendant will record all guests in a guest book.
 - c) Member guests will be limited to a total of five (5) per month and will be charged at a rate of \$3.00 per guest, whether adult or child. Members exceeding the five (5) local quota will be charged \$5.00 per guest, whether adult or child.
 - d) An exception to the above rule will be made to members desiring to bring baseball teams, birthday parties, church groups, etc. to the pool during normal hours. Members must check with the pool manager for availability of space and are to be at the gate upon entry of the group. On the date of the function, the member must supply the names of all guests (forms provided by the manager) and pay the local guest rate of \$3.00 per guest to the pool manager. This will not count against the monthly local quota. These functions should not disturb the members using the pool. There is to be no loud music or DJ's.
 - e) Local guests will be determined by their zip codes and shall include the following zip codes: 15001, 15003, 15108, 15046, 15081, 15056, 15143.
 - f) No persons may be a local guest at the pool more than twice a month.
 - g) Guests living in areas other than the above stated zip code areas shall be considered out of town guests and WILL NOT be limited to twice a month. The fee for out of town guests will be \$3.00 per guest, whether adult or child.
 - h) Adult guests may be entertained at evening parties (rentals) without regard to local guest rules.
 - i) A member who is a long term babysitter, that brings a nonmember child to the pool, will be subject to standard guest fees and visitation limits for each child. A nonmember, long term babysitter who accompanies a member child to the pool, will be subject to a \$3.00 fee per visit, with an unlimited number of visits. This fee is to be paid by the member. In all long term babysitting situations, the pool manager must be notified of the circumstances in writing. You can also use the ADD A SITTER option to your membership for \$50.00. Please see the manager for the proper form.
 - * **j) The sponsoring member will take full and sole responsibility for policing their guest behavior, language and alcohol consumption.**
